立法會再議飲品容器生產者責任制 綠惜地球倡實行1元按金制

LegCo Re-discussed the Producer Responsibility Scheme for Beverage Containers; The Green Earth called for a \$1 Deposit-return Scheme

TGE Deputy Director Rico Wong discussed how a deposit return scheme can reduce beverage packaging waste in an interview with NowTV.

立法會在今年 2 月討論塑膠飲料容器及紙包飲品盒生產者責任計劃，本會聯同三大環團去信飲品商、立法會議員及環保部門，促請將初始回收率定於 70%，實行 1 元按金制，並加入更多零售舖作回收點，以有效的經濟誘因和便利性，鼓勵全民參與回收，減少飲品容器廢物。

In February, the Legislative Council revisited the producer responsibility scheme on Plastic Beverage Containers and Beverage Cartons. We had submitted a joint petition letter with three green groups to beverage companies, LegCo members, and the environmental authorities, urging them to set an initial recovery rate of 70%, implement a \$1 deposit scheme, and designate more retail stores as return points. These measures, combined with effective economic incentives and greater convenience, would encourage public participation in recycling and reducing beverage packaging waste.

Rise in energy use for a third of Hong Kong government offices: study

NGOs urge explanation over findings the offices used more energy in 2023-24 than five years ago; government says it is on track for targets

本會調查發現，七幢政府合署的用電量較 5 年前增逾一成，以致電費開支飛漲。機電署更提醒部分政府部門須調節其建築物的室內溫度，反映電費增加無助促使部門節能。本會建議由機電署和環境及生態局監察政府節能，而政府建築物亦須全面進行能源審核，找出節能空間，並實施相應措施。

According to our research, seven government buildings have seen their electricity consumption increase by more than 10% compared to five years ago, leading to a sharp rise in electricity bills. The EMSD has even reminded some departments managing these buildings to adjust indoor temperatures, highlighting that rising electricity costs have not driven departments to conserve energy. We recommend that the EMSD and the Environment and Ecology Bureau jointly monitor energy-saving efforts across all departments. Additionally, all government buildings should conduct comprehensive energy audits to identify energy-saving opportunities and implement corresponding measures.

The Green Earth Night Walk 2025 was successfully held on 15 February in Pak Tam Chung, Sai Kung. About 500 participants enjoyed a low-carbon and low-waste eco-journey by connecting with nature through their senses, learning about Leave No Trace principles and sustainable trails, admiring the starry sky, and gaining insights into light pollution.

The event upheld the zero-waste principle by encouraging participants to bring their reusable tableware and water bottles. This minimised the environmental impact and demonstrated that promoting waste reduction at the source and moving away from disposable items can unlock immense potential in Hong Kong's mega events.
